

The Missing Drive Tweak For Windows XP

There is a minor bug in Windows XP that will occasionally cause XP to lose track of a drive in the system. This usually happens after a major update, or program installation/uninstallation. Rarely, it will also happen at random.

Fortunately, we have a fix for it. Open up your registry editor, and take the following steps...

1. Just in case, export a copy of your registry to a file.
2. Browse to registry Key:
HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SYSTEM\CurrentControlSet\Control\Class
3. Locate key Name:
{4D36E965-E325-11CE-BFC1-08002BE10318}
4. Delete Value Data from "UpperFilters" and "LowerFilters" areas.

Note: Do not delete the Key or the Multi-String Values. Delete only the data values.

5. Exit Registry editor, and Reboot
