Use:

Call SlideWindow(wnd As Form, modStyle As Integer, modCenterStop As Boolean)

wnd = Name of form to slide. (aka: wnd=Me)

modCenterStop As Boolean : Slide to center screen (true)

False : Peek over the edge

True : Stop movement at center screen.

modStyle As Const:

vbBottomSide	(0)	Enter from bottom
vbTopSide	(1)	Enter from top
vbLeftSide	(2)	Enter from left
vbRightSide	(3)	Enter from right
vbHidelt	(4)	Drop from screen

Simply add this module as an “existing” module to your current project, then use it as described to slide the form in question in from the specified side (modStyle=X), stopping at either the form edge, using (modCenterStop=False) or to the center of the screen (modCenterSteop-True).

To make the form slide back off the screen, use a value of modeStyle=vbHidelt (or 4).
